Dear Friend of CAC Activities:

On Friday, May 18, 2018, 7:00 p.m., we would like for you to join us in the Friends of Coldwater Attendance Center Athletic Banquet. We will honor nearly 100 student athletes. We've taken up this challenge to celebrate our "comeback year" and to raise funds to continually support school activities in a meaningful way. We need your financial support to ensure our success.

We have a fundraising goal for this banquet of \$20,000. With those funds, we will provide dinner for the athletes and two guests per athlete. Additionally, each athlete will receive a certificate of participation and a commemorative medallion. Our funds will also cover the cost of individual and team awards as determined by the coaching staff. Finally, with the remaining funds, we will have seed money to support the school's preparations for 2018-19 school year activities and provide a summer internship for two of these athletes to develop our alumni database.

To help us reach our goal, you may donate as follows:
