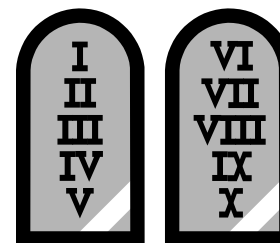

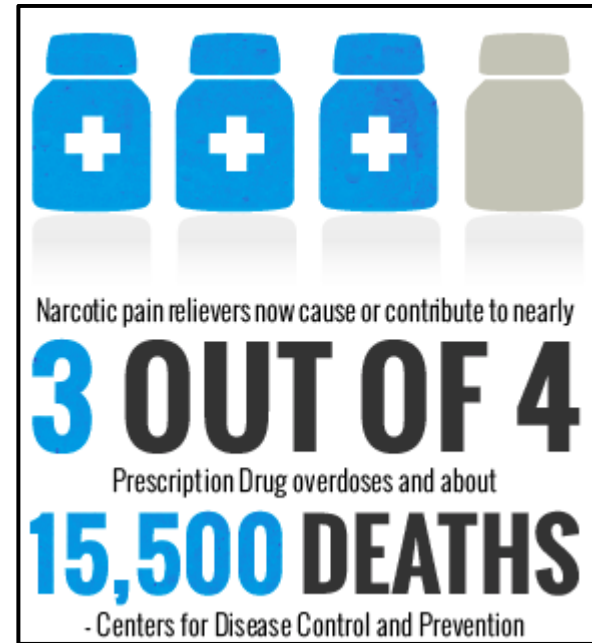

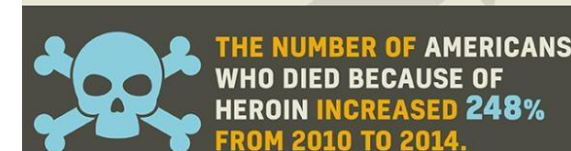

RESULTING IN OVERDOSE OR DEATH.



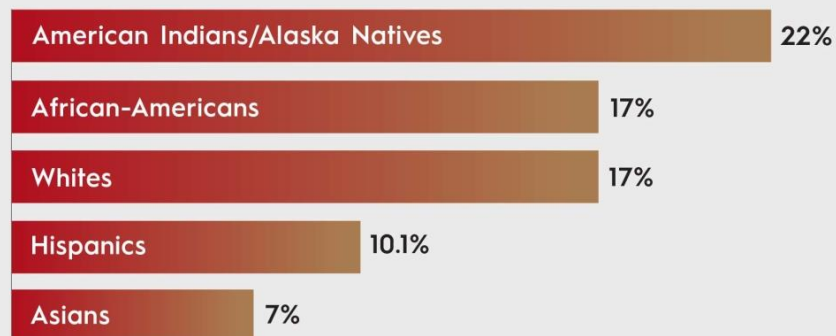

While the prevalence of smoking among African-Americans and whites is virtually the same, American Indians and Alaska Natives are twice as likely to smoke compared with Hispanics and nearly three times as likely as Asians. A new study links heavy smoking in African-Americans to increased diabetes risk.
