ABOUT US

The Mid-South Churches Cooperative Conference (MCCC) is a fellowship of Mid-South churches dedicated to the promotion of Christian education through the fulfillment of the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20). The MSCCC is a representing state convention in the **National Baptist Convention, USA, Incorporated (NBCUSA)**.

Vision: We will become the leading Christian education voice among National Baptist Churches and other doctrinally aligned churches.

Mission: We will achieve our vision by staying true to Christ's Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20.

Brief History: MSCCC began as an informal network of pastors committed to Christian education, health and wellness, and economic development in 2002. On August 8, 2008, Pastor Michael O. Minor launched a web portal. Through the years, Mid-South Churches hosted a number of Christian education workshops and an online regional calendar of events. In December 2011, at the move of the Holy Spirit among pastors in North Mississippi, the web portal was transformed into a full-fledged conference of churches. In June 2012, the MSCCC affiliated with the NBCUSA.

Dues Structure: Member churches support MSCCC regular operations (except special events) through quarterly support. Other than free will offerings during sessions, participating churches pay no other required fees.
